I believe it was Bill Hybels who said years ago, “**If it is in the word it should be in the world.**” Well, we see the providence of God in the word with such actions as raising up Cyrus who would send the Jews back to Israel following the seventy year captivity.

We also see numerous examples in the American Revolution of God’s Providence. The question I ask is, “Why not today?” Well, the truth is, He IS at work today and we need to join Him.

I like to say that while Israel was God’s “Chosen Nation,” because of God’s covenant with Abraham, America is God’s “Choosing Nation.” Israel was chosen to follow God. America, on the other hand, chose to follow God. Notice this poignant passage in **Isaiah 56:3-8** (ESV):

³ Let not the foreigner who has joined himself to the LORD say,

“The LORD will surely separate me from his people”;

and let not the eunuch say,

“Behold, I am a dry tree.”

⁴ For thus says the LORD:

“To the eunuchs who keep my Sabbaths,

who choose the things that please me

and hold fast my covenant,

⁵ I will give in my house and within my walls

a monument and a name

better than sons and daughters;

I will give them an everlasting name

that shall not be cut off.

⁶ “And the foreigners who join themselves to the LORD,

to minister to him, to love the name of the LORD,

and to be his servants,

everyone who keeps the Sabbath and does not profane it,

and holds fast my covenant—

⁷ these I will bring to my holy mountain,

and make them joyful in my house of prayer;

their burnt offerings and their sacrifices

will be accepted on my altar;

for my house shall be called a house of prayer

for all peoples.”

⁸ The Lord GOD,

who gathers the outcasts of Israel, declares,

“I will gather yet others to him

besides those already gathered.”

God considers those outside the family of Israel who choose Him as “better than sons and daughters.” What a privilege to follow God! Our Founders thought so and came to America to eventually establish a nation that was based on Him and His Word.

As I mentioned, I want to draw from scripture, draw from history, and then make practical application to our current situations. For instance, the recent election fraud.

- Biblically we were established as a republic based on Exodus 18 and some other passages.
- Historically, our Founders treated our republic with respect and awe. Critical to the republic was the means by which we chose our representatives. That was done by the vote which they treated as a sacred duty. **Samuel Adams** said:
Let each citizen remember at the moment he is offering his vote that he is not making a present or a compliment to please an individual – or at least that he ought not so to do; but that he is executing one of the most solemn trusts in human society for which he is accountable to God and his country.
- The application, in this case, deals with demanding a forensic audit along with canvassing in order to determine if fraud was actual. If so, we must make corrections because without a true and honest election we have nothing as a republic.

I started this ministry effort in the fall of 2020. I did not realize that there are not many churches that are interested in the effort I am putting forth. Most prefer to be silent and disengaged from the current culture and crises. So I am working on a number of outlets for my work.

²⁴“Everyone then who hears these words of mine and does them will be like a wise man who built his house on the rock. ²⁵And the rain fell, and the floods came, and the winds blew and beat on that house, but it did not fall, because it had been founded on the rock. ²⁶And everyone who hears these words of mine and does not do them will be like a foolish man who built his house on the sand. ²⁷And the rain fell, and the floods came, and the winds blew and beat against that house, and it fell, and great was the fall of it.”

The Frenchman, Alexis de Tocqueville came to America to study us and see what made our young country so great. He wrote a book entitled “Democracy in America. In it he stated the reason for our greatness. He said:

I sought for the greatness and genius of America in her commodious harbors and her ample rivers, and it was not there; in her fertile fields and boundless prairies, and it was not there; in her rich mines and

her vast world commence, and it was not there. *Not until I went into the churches of America and heard her pulpits aflame with righteousness did I understand the secret of her genius and power.*¹

The source of our greatness is not our intelligence. It is not in our talent. It is in our God. We need GodNAmerica.

NUREMBERG TRIALS²

After World War II ended, officials of the National Socialist Workers Party were arrested and put on trial for killing millions of Jews and others in the Holocaust. At the Nuremberg Trials of 1945-1946, on full display was the socialist idea that rights come from "the group," and not God. Nazi officials defended their actions by explaining they were only following "laws agreed upon" by the people of the German state. An insight into the perpetrators mindset was provided by Nazi General Hans Frank, who carried out orders to plunder Poland and commit the mass murder of millions of Poles and Jews in death camps.

At his trial, August 31, 1945, Hans Frank was remorseful as he described the false justification for his acts and the slippery slope of socialist thought:

At the beginning of our way we did not suspect that our turning away from God could have such disastrous deadly consequences and that we would necessarily become more and more deeply involved in guilt. At that time we could not have known that so much loyalty and willingness to sacrifice on the part of the German people could have been so badly directed by us. Thus, by turning away from God, we were overthrown and had to perish ...

Frank continued:

Before all, God pronounced and executed judgment on Hitler and the system which we served with minds far from God. Therefore, may our people, too, be called back from the road on which Hitler – and we with him – have led them. I beg of our people NOT to continue in this direction, be it even a single step; because Hitler's road was the way without God, the way of turning from Christ, and, in the last analysis, the way of political foolishness, the way of disaster, and the way of death...

We call upon the German people ... to return from this road which, according to the law and justice of God, had to lead us and our system into disaster and which will lead everyone into disaster who tries to walk on it... everywhere in the whole world.
