Greetings Patriots! This is Perry Greene with GNA. Last week I went out on a limb and bypassed the normal Sunday interview and just rambled about my take on some of the current issues (thus the title, "Perry's Scope" not to be confused with a periscope). I received some favorable feedback and so I thought I would do another Perry's Scope this week on the Georgia Guidestones before they get too far away. I must warn you that this episode got much longer than I intended when I began it. I hope you will stay with me to the end.

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At the outset, I found it interesting that not many knew about the Guidestones. There are some people who have been aware of the Stones. There are those in the camp of the people who put them up, and that is, those whom we would call "Globalists." These people want the New World Order, and the One World Government inscribed on the Stones.

Another category of people who knew about the Stones was the "conspiracists." These people believe something is amiss and that there is an oligarchy in control of the world. Someone has asked, "What is the difference between a conspiracy and truth?" The answer is, "About six months." In the case of the Georgia Guidestones, it has been forty-two years.

If you are not in either of these groups you probably haven't paid much attention to the Georgia Guidestones and have not questioned JFK's assassination or the twin towers' destruction on 9.11. Some conspiracists question the lunar landing, Covid and the Covid shots, the upcoming Monkey Pox (or Money Pox) "Plandemic," and many other events that we generally take at face value. In a few minutes, I will tell you one conspiracy theory regarding the Guidestones. Then you research and come to your conclusion. The fun thing is that we get to think for ourselves rather than being brainwashed by the propagandists on TV.

The Georgia Guidestones, sometimes referred to as an "American Stonehenge," appeared on the scene in Elbert County, Georgia, on March 22, 1980 (numerically, March 22 is 322, which, according to conspiracists, is symbolic of specific clandestine and evil organizations like *Skull and Bones*. We should be wary of most if not all secret societies. If they are on the up and up, why are they secret? Jesus reveals the truth, secret societies conceal their teachings). As a result of the secrecy, some have connected the Stones to Satanists.

The Georgia Guidestones were composed of four large rectangular stones on a base with a stone covering them on the top. The creators of the Guidestones are unknown to us. An individual identifying himself as "RC Christian" commissioned the monument on behalf of "*a small group of loyal Americans*." This moniker is even inscribed on the stones. The overall height of the Stones was 19 feet 3 inches tall and made from six granite slabs weighing a total of 237,746 pounds. The four main vertical Stones were sixteen feet, four inches in height. This was a costly endeavor.

Wikipedia described the day of the unveiling (https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Georgia_Guidestones):

On March 22, 1980, the monument was unveiled by Congressman Doug Barnard before an audience of between 200 and 300 people. At the unveiling, the Master of Ceremonies read a message to the gathered audience:

"In order to avoid debate, we the sponsors of the Georgia Guidestones have a simple message for human beings, now and for the future. We believe our precepts are sound, and they must stand on their own merits."

- Purported statement of Georgia Guidestones sponsors

Some believe this small group of concerned Americans erected the Stones in case of a cataclysmic event occurred future generations would know how to survive. Of course, that is speculation. Others believe that this is a project of the NWO and Great Reset which want to eliminate over 90% of the world's population.

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The small group of concerned Americans engraved ten guidelines or principles on the Georgia Guidestones in eight different languages. The languages are:

English, Spanish, Swahili, Hindi, Hebrew, Arabic, Traditional Chinese, and Russian. Hebrew is connected to Judaism, and Christianity while the other languages compose most of the world's population.

The Wikipedia article points out that the inscriptions dealt with four main themes: "governance and the establishment of a world government, population and reproduction control, the environment, and humankind's relationship to nature, and spirituality." Let me read and briefly discuss the ten guidelines.

1. Maintain humanity under 500,000,000 in perpetual balance with nature.

If you are culturally "woke," this sounds totally amenable. This guideline, however, is in direct opposition to the will of God. God never said to limit the population of the earth. In fact, God said the opposite. Listen to **Genesis 1:27-28** (NKJV):

²⁷ So God created man in His *own* image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them. ²⁸ Then God blessed them, and God said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it; have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves on the earth."

He repeats this command to Noah and his sons in Genesis 9:1.

We keep hearing about overpopulation on earth, and for the most part, we have bought into it in one form or another. Who do you think is behind that propaganda, God or His adversary? I read somewhere that the world's population of over 7 Billion today could fit inside the state of Texas, leaving the rest of the earth open for expansion.

This leads us to the second guideline.

2. Guide reproduction wisely – improving fitness and diversity.

This guideline aligns closely with the first. Satan hates children and does not want us to reproduce and create more people to worship God. He wants the opposite of God's desire for us to be fruitful and multiply.

We have engaged in eugenics for generations. Margaret Sanger and others, including Bill Gates' father, have been interested in population control. Sanger even wanted to control or annihilate people of African descent. Hitler took lessons from the American practices of eugenics in trying to exterminate the Jewish people in the holocaust during WWII.

It is a lack of faith and a slap in the face of God to, under normal circumstances, limit reproduction on earth. Who decides who is fit and who is unfit to reproduce? In the last century, America sterilized the mentally challenged and the criminally insane. If we start there, where does it end and who decides who is in and who is out?

3. Unite humanity with a living new language.

This is reminiscent of the days of the tower of Babel. Rather than going out into the world as God had directed, Nimrod led people to stay in one place and create one nation with one language. Listen to **Genesis 11:1-9**

Now the whole earth had one language and one speech. ² And it came to pass, as they journeyed from the east, that they found a plain in the land of Shinar, and they dwelt there....⁴ And they said, "Come, let us build ourselves a city, and a tower whose top *is* in the heavens; let us make a name for ourselves, lest we be scattered abroad over the face of the whole earth."

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⁵ But the LORD came down to see the city and the tower which the sons of men had built. ⁶ And the LORD said, "Indeed the people *are* one and they all have one language, and this is what they begin to do; now nothing that they propose to do will be withheld from them. ⁷ Come, let Us go down and there confuse their language, that they may not understand one another's speech." ⁸ So the LORD scattered them abroad from there over the face of all the earth, and they ceased building the city. ⁹ Therefore its name is called Babel, because there the LORD confused the language of all the earth; and from there the LORD scattered them abroad over the face of all the earth.

God repeated His multiplication mandate to Noah in **Genesis 9:1**. Instead of overspreading the earth, the world congregated at Babel to make their name great by building a tall tower or "Ziggurat." A Ziggurat was a temple complex to connect heaven and earth. They wanted to meet at that place to offer sacrifice and barter with the gods, that is, to bring deity to them, which was not God's plan. God will not be tamed and under our control. Because they were not loyal to God, He gave them what they wanted, a divorce, and He kicked them out. As a result, He dispersed them and formed nations. Through all this, the LORD's heritage is Jacob or Israel, who would honor Him. Listen to a few verses about God setting up nations.

Paul spoke at Mars Hill in Athens and told how God set up nations including their languages – Acts 17:26-28 (NKJV)

²⁶ And He has made from one blood every nation of men to dwell on all the face of the earth, and has determined their pre-appointed times and the boundaries of their dwellings, ²⁷ so that they should seek the Lord, in the hope that they might grope for Him and find Him, though He is not far from each one of us;

The passage Paul to which alludes is **Deuteronomy 32:8-9** (NKJV): ⁸ When the Most High divided their inheritance to the nations, When He separated the sons of Adam, He set the boundaries of the peoples According to the number of the children of Israel. ⁹ For the LORD's portion *is* His people; Jacob *is* the place of His inheritance.

As long as I have been a Christian, teachers told me that Paul was discerning of his audience here (and he was). They say that Paul did not use scripture because he was talking to pagan philosophers instead of Jewish people who knew the scriptures. Paul may not have quoted book, chapter, and verse in his speech but he plainly used scripture, that is, the "sword of the Spirit" to undergird his points. Here is another passage regarding Daniel's vision of the Son of man to consider:

Daniel 7:14 (ESV) ¹⁴ And to him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve him;

We could continue on this one point, but for the sake of time, let me hasten on.

4. *Rule* passion – faith – tradition – and all things with tempered reason.

Whose reason is to temper our passion, faith, and tradition, God or philosophers?

The Bible says in **Titus 2:11-14** (NKJV) that God is the one to temper our self-control:

¹¹ For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men, ¹² teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly in the present age, ¹³ looking for the blessed hope and glorious appearing of our great God

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and Savior Jesus Christ, ¹⁴ who gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us from every lawless deed and purify for Himself *His* own special people, zealous for good works.

5. Protect people and nations with fair laws and just courts.

This sounds good – but, what is the legal standard? Who judges?

The rule of law in America was once according to the "laws of nature and nature's God." Today justices legislate from the bench according to the Marxist agenda or their whim and not law and certainly not the laws of God. We have, for instance, a SCOTUS justice who cannot define "woman" and went against the law regarding the punishment of convicted pedophiles. It is only going to get worse as we progress without God and judge by the standards of men.

- 6. Let all nations rule internally resolving external disputes in a world court. Again, what is the legal standard? Who judges? If we "*Rule passion – faith – tradition – and all things with tempered reason*," could we not settle things between nations rather than a world court? This sounds more like control than international justice.
- 7. Avoid petty laws and useless officials.

Who decides which laws are petty and which officials? Would they consider a county sheriff a "petty official?" The Bible has some seemingly petty laws that people tend to overlook. However, people have found that when they honor God by following even the least commandments they benefit.

8. Balance personal rights with social duties.

This statement is the mantra that we should "Sacrifice our rights for the good of everyone else." Get the Covid jab because it will help grandma. Wear a facial covering, or you don't love other people. Recently I heard of some aggressive leaders in a local church who were over the top regarding the masks and the shots that came down with Covid. Do you find it interesting that their facial masks and injections did not protect them? They sacrificed personal rights and wanted everyone else to as well for nothing. The precautions did not protect them or those around them. Their infections prove that the government has lied to us about our safety.

Benjamin Franklin purportedly said:

"Those who would give up essential Liberty, to purchase a little temporary Safety, deserve neither Liberty nor Safety." Apparently our inalienable rights are crucial to our social duties. We are not to sacrifice these rights but use them for the benefit of ourselves and others.

9. *Prize truth – beauty – love – seeking harmony with the infinite.*

This may be the only statement of real value. WHO is the infinite and source of beauty, truth, and love? God is the only true Source of these things. Truth, beauty, and love are not arbitrary or individualized, they are absolutes in the ultimate.

10. Be not a cancer on the Earth – Leave room for nature – Leave room for nature.

If we follow God, we will be stewards of the earth, not cancer of the earth. The Globalists worship and serve nature rather than nature's God. Man is subordinated in their agenda while nature is elevated. That is why aborting a helpless baby is acceptable to them but cracking an eagle's egg is not.

Do you find it interesting that there are TEN guidelines? Could this be comparable to or an imitation of God giving Israel His Ten Commandments at Sinai? Is this small group of concerned Americans trying to compete with the God of the universe?

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Astronomical features

The four outer stones were oriented to mark the limits of the 18.6 year lunar declination cycle. The center column featured a hole drilled at an angle from one side to the other, through which the North Star could be seen. The same pillar had a slot carved through it which was aligned with the Sun's solstices and equinoxes. A $\frac{7}{8}$ -in (22 mm) aperture in the capstone allowed a ray of sun to pass through at noon each day, shining a beam on the center stone indicating the day of the year.

I don't know if this is an attempt to worship or follow the stars, it may be a guide to the movement of the stars. The stars have functions for us but God is the One whom we worship and serve. Don't forget God's warning in **Deuteronomy 4:19** (NKJV):

¹⁹ And *take heed*, lest you lift your eyes to heaven, and *when* you see the sun, the moon, and the stars, all the host of heaven, you feel driven to worship them and serve them, which the LORD your God has given to all the peoples under the whole heaven as a heritage.

In addition to following the stars rather than the Star-maker, men have looked for guidance from a variety of sources.

- The dead as when Saul went to the witch of Endor and conjured up the spirit of Samuel
- Demons who are behind the gods such as Moloch and Baal. Listen to Paul's admonition in 1 Corinthians 10:19-20 (NKJV):

¹⁹ What am I saying then? That an idol is anything, or what is offered to idols is anything? ²⁰ Rather, that the things which the Gentiles sacrifice they sacrifice to demons and not to God, and I do not want you to have fellowship with demons.

- Angels as John in Revelation
- Friends/Advisors as when Rehoboam asked for advice regarding the taxation of Israel
- "Sorcerers," which includes palm readers, Ouija boards, et al. Listen to God's direction as the new generation was about to enter the Promised Land in Deuteronomy 18:10-12a (NKJV):
 ¹⁰ There shall not be found among you *anyone* who makes his son or his

¹⁰ There shall not be found among you *anyone* who makes his son or his daughter pass through the fire, *or one* who practices witchcraft, *or* a soothsayer, or one who interprets omens, or a sorcerer, ¹¹ or one who conjures spells, or a medium, or a spiritist, or one who calls up the dead. ¹² For all who do these things *are* an abomination to the LORD,

Have you watched the security camera video of the blast that took down one of the Guidestones? Did you notice anything unusual? On July 6, 2022, some kind of explosion heavily damaged the monument. Within twenty-four hours the county completely dismantled and removed the Guidestones. Do you find that odd?

Whoever was watching the security feed from the monument site did not see or at least release any video of the person(s) who planted the explosive device, if indeed it was a planted device. The removal of the stones seems odd in that this should have been a crime scene and should have been preserved for the criminal investigation. I wonder why they removed the stones so quickly.

There are some theories about the destruction of the Guidestones. One is that someone planted a bomb to vandalize the monument. Another is that God took down the monument with a lightning bolt. Another is that Space Force shot it with an energy beam. Yet another is that it is a false flag. Someone did set a charge at the monument, but it was not anti-satanic people, it was the builders who planted the bomb in order to point suspicion at "conspiracy nuts."

Whatever the origin of the Georgia Guidestones, they most likely are not from faithful followers of Jesus, and these seem more likely from the other side. These Guidestones are not the first time someone has erected a monument to instruct future generations on how to live.

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Kirk Cameron introduced many of us to the "*National Monument to the Forefathers*" in his movie *Monumental.* That movie gave us insights into the Pilgrims' progress in coming to America and the ordeal they endured to get here to worship God freely and advance the Christian faith. The movie showed us the *Forefathers' Monument* that gives us the key ingredients to life and liberty. In a sense, it is a formula in stone for future generations who would forget the process. The people of long ago were wiser than we, and they knew we would fail and need to be reminded of God and the will of God to be free.

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I hope that sometime in the not-too-distant future I will be able to do Perry's Scope on the *Forefathers' Monument*. I also hope to go to New England one day and see it in person.

The only Guide Stone we should truly pay attention to is the One the builders rejected. Jesus quoted **Psalm 118:22-23** in the "Parable of the Wicked Vinedressers" in **Mark 12:10-11** (NKJV) which reads:

¹⁰ Have you not even read this Scripture:
'The stone which the builders rejected Has become the chief cornerstone.
¹¹ This was the LORD's doing, And it is marvelous in our eyes'?"

Peter addressed the Jewish leaders in regard to a lame man he had healed. He too quoted from **Psalm 118** and pointed them to Jesus. Listen to **Acts 4:10-12** (NKJV):

¹⁰ let it be known to you all, and to all the people of Israel, that by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom you crucified, whom God raised from the dead, by Him this man stands here before you whole. ¹¹ This is the 'stone which was rejected by you builders, which has become the chief cornerstone.' ¹² Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved.

God is our ultimate and practical Guide. He may guide us as the Father, Son, or Holy Spirit. Jesus said in **John 16:13** (NKJV):

However, when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth; for He will not speak on His own *authority*, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come.

In John 14:6 He declared that HE is truth and the way we should follow.

We must be wary of whom we follow. John warns us to "test" or "try the spirits" (or teachers) in **1 John 4:1** (NKJV):

Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits, whether they are of God; because many false prophets have gone out into the world.

Our forefathers knew God and knew to take direction from Him. Listen to a few quotes indicating that the Founders and Framers believed in God and surrendered to His leadership in their lives and the life of the nation.

My favorite of the Founding Fathers is Dr. **Benjamin Rush**. In his autobiography, **Dr. Rush** wrote: "The Gospel of Jesus Christ prescribes the wisest rules for just conduct in every situation of life. Happy they who are enabled to obey them in all situations! . . . My only hope of salvation is in the infinite transcendent love of God manifested to the world by the death of His Son upon the Cross. Nothing but His blood will wash away my sins [Acts 22:16]. I rely exclusively upon it. Come, Lord Jesus! Come quickly! [Revelation 22:20]."

In his Last Will and Testament, which he wrote on November 20, 1798, the firebrand, **Patrick Henry** stated:

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I have now disposed of all my property to my family; there is one thing more I wish I could give them, and that is the Christian religion. If they had that, and I had not given them one shilling, they would be rich, and if they had not that, and I had given them all the world, they would be poor. This is all the inheritance I give to my dear family. The religion of Christ will give them one which will make them rich indeed.

Here are some George Washington Quotes:

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...the propitious smiles of Heaven can never be expected on a nation that disregards the eternal rules of order and right which Heaven itself has ordained..." George Washington, First Inaugural, April 30, 1789

"What will be the consequences of our Arming for self-defense, that Providence, who permits these doings in the Disturbers of Mankind; and who rules and Governs all things, alone can tell. To its allpowerful decrees, we must submit, whilst we hope that the injustice of our Cause if War, must ensue, will entitle us to its Protection."

-Letter to Revered Jonathan Boucher, August 15, 1798

"While I reiterate the professions of my dependence upon Heaven as the source of all public and private blessings; I will observe that the general prevalence of piety, philanthropy, honesty, industry, and economy seems, in the ordinary course of human affairs particularly necessary for advancing and conforming the happiness of our country." – Answering a letter from the General Assembly of Presbyterian Churches in the United States, May, 1789

The Georgia Guidestones may seem mystical and enlightening but test their words with God's words. The Forefathers' Monument may be inspirational, but test its precepts with God's precepts. HE is our Rock, our Fortress, and our Guide. Paul reminds us in Colossians 2:8-10 (NKJV):

⁸ Beware lest anyone cheat you through philosophy and empty deceit, according to the tradition of men, according to the basic principles of the world, and not according to Christ. ⁹ For in Him dwells all the fullness of the Godhead bodily; ¹⁰ and you are complete in Him, who is the head of all principality and power.

This Perry's Scope has been much longer than I anticipated when I began it. I hope you hung in with me to the end. The Guidestones typify our world today. We are starving for guidance but we look in the wrong places. Idols of stone cannot give us guidance, even if they are inscribed with high-sounding words. We need God to guide us.

One day God will remove all falsehood and deception. All mankind will know that He told us the truth to guide our steps. Did HE remove the Guidestones with a lightning bolt from heaven or through the efforts of men? Either way, He is at work.

Let's Keep The Light of God's Guidance Burning for our lives and the life of our nation!
