130-3 God's Alarm System

Let's begin with a lengthy Bible reading, Ezekiel 33:1-7 (NKJV):

Again, the word of the LORD came to me, saying, ² "Son of man, speak to the children of your people and say to them: 'When I bring the sword upon a land, and the people of the land take a man from their territory and make him their watchman, ³ when he sees the sword coming upon the land if he blows the trumpet and warns the people, ⁴ then whoever hears the sound of the trumpet and does not take warning, if the sword comes and takes him away, his blood shall be on his *own* head. ⁵ He heard the sound of the trumpet but did not take warning; his blood shall be upon himself. But he who takes warning will save his life. ⁶ But if the watchman sees the sword coming and does not blow the trumpet, and the people are not warned, and the sword comes and takes *any* person from among them, he is taken away in his iniquity; but his blood I will require at the watchman's hand.' ⁷ "So you, son of man: I have made you a watchman for the house of Israel; therefore you shall hear a word from My mouth and warn them for Me.

We have a responsibility to tell people what we know. They may listen, they may not, but we still tell. We warn people about the dangers of hell and of the fall of our nation in our disobedience to God. We need God to prevent both.

Years ago, workers in East London, England, paid people to wake them each morning so they would not lose their jobs. These wake-up specialists were known as "**Knocker-Uppers**" and often shot peas against window panes to alert their clients to the morning hour. They found that they woke the neighbors for free when they knocked on a client's door, so they became more creative in their wake-up methods. They realized they could wake their clients quickly from outside without disturbing anyone on the street or next door. Mary Smith was a favorite pea shooting Knocker-Upper in the 1930s. Her nearest competitor was three miles away, who tapped windows with a fishing rod. Smith was so famous that she became the subject of children's books.

Ezekiel, Mary Smith, and Christian Patriots have this in common: waking people from sleep. Most Americans are asleep and do not realize the intensity of the dangers facing our land. We are rapidly approaching the precipice of no return.

Since we drifted into our collective national slumber, evil has come out into the open with the express purpose of destroying the USA. As **Nikita Khrushchev** stated years ago, Communists would take over America without firing a shot. They have succeeded by lulling us to sleep and undermining the foundations of our country. Piece by piece, they have taken over our elections, the education system (now Oregon is not requiring math and reading to graduate from High School, what could possibly go wrong with that?). They have taken our media, our legislators, medical system, and laugh with glee at the "useful idiots" (as they call them), who have worked with them to pull off this coup. **CS Lewis** wrote in the *Screwtape Letters*:

Jesus told a parable about genuine wheat plants and the imitation tares in Matthew 13. I'll read the beginning:

²⁴ Another parable He put forth to them, saying: "The kingdom of heaven is like a man who sowed good seed in his field; ²⁵ but while men slept, his enemy came and sowed tares among the wheat and went his way. ²⁶ But when the grain had sprouted and produced a crop, then the tares also appeared.

The workers wanted to uproot the tares, but the owner told them to wait until the harvest so as not to harm the wheat.

When the plan-demic came, God revealed the genuine disciples from the imitation, the awake from the sleeping. Big Brother has brainwashed many Americans, including Christians. Is there any wonder why so many churches are going out of business? Just like the hireling, when the wolf comes, they flee. It is time for us to wake up and sound the alarm to wake the sleepers. Listen to these reminders.
